Judith Cohen, M.D. and Anthony Mannarino, Ph.D. are the leaders of the Allegheny General Hospital Center for Traumatic Stress in Children and Adolescents, where they run a Treatment and Services Adaptation Center specializing in child and adolescent traumatic grief. Drs. Cohen and Mannarino, in collaboration with acclaimed researcher Esther Deblinger, Ph.D., are authors of the book Treating Trauma and Traumatic Grief in Children and Adolescents from Guilford Press.

Allegheny General Hospital's Center for Traumatic Stress in Children and Adolescents serves children and families who experience traumatic or stressful events in their lives. This program provides prompt evaluation and treatment of children who have experienced a variety of traumatic life events. Major goals of the Center for Traumatic Stress are to alleviate serious symptoms and promote healthy coping responses in traumatized children and their families.
